- Teach assigned courses as contracted.
- Provide all necessary information and teach materials as outlined in the syllabus.

- Meet for all schedule class meetings for the assigned term.
- Be available to students before and after class for individual consultation.
- Abide by and uphold core values and mission of SEU at Chapelhill, Chapelhill Church, and Southeastern University.
- Model strong Christian character, integrity, growing relationship with Christ.
- Submit final grades within one week of the end of term.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Excellent oral, written language, and number skills.
- Must have a master's degree, with at least 18 hours of completed graduate coursework in the discipline area of interest.
- Ability to integrate faith and learning.
